## **Documentation:**

Detailed records related to health and safety—including training, inspections, and incidents—will be maintained to support accountability.



## **Continuous Improvement:**

The policy will be reviewed annually to incorporate legislative changes, best practices, and feedback from the school community.

# **Legal and Regulatory Compliance:**

We will ensure that all health and safety operations align with local and federal laws and ADEK's policies.

# **Emergency Plans and Drills:**

Emergency plans, including fire safety and lockdown procedures, will be developed and regularly tested to ensure preparedness and safety.
